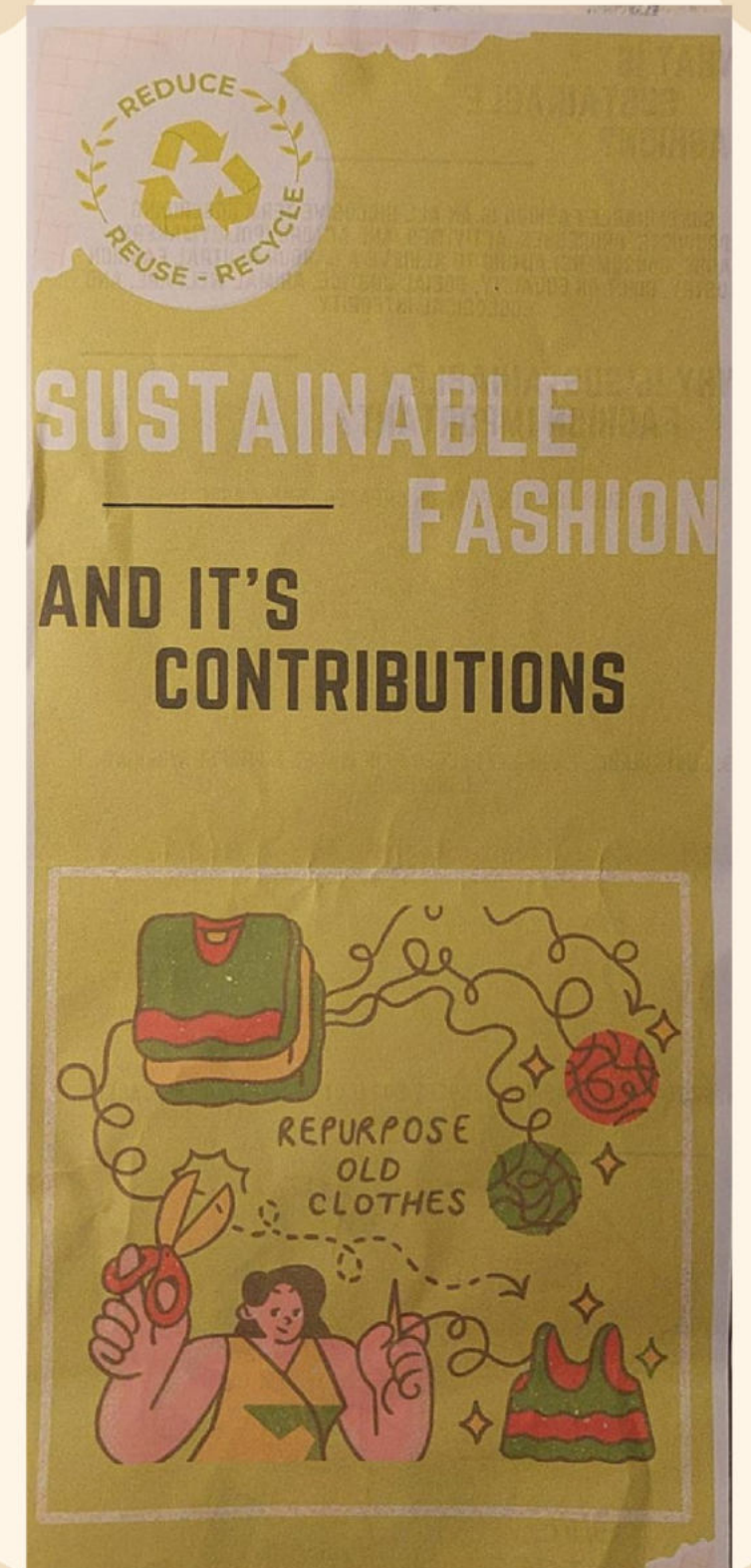
Cosmetics Workshop

Gdańsk

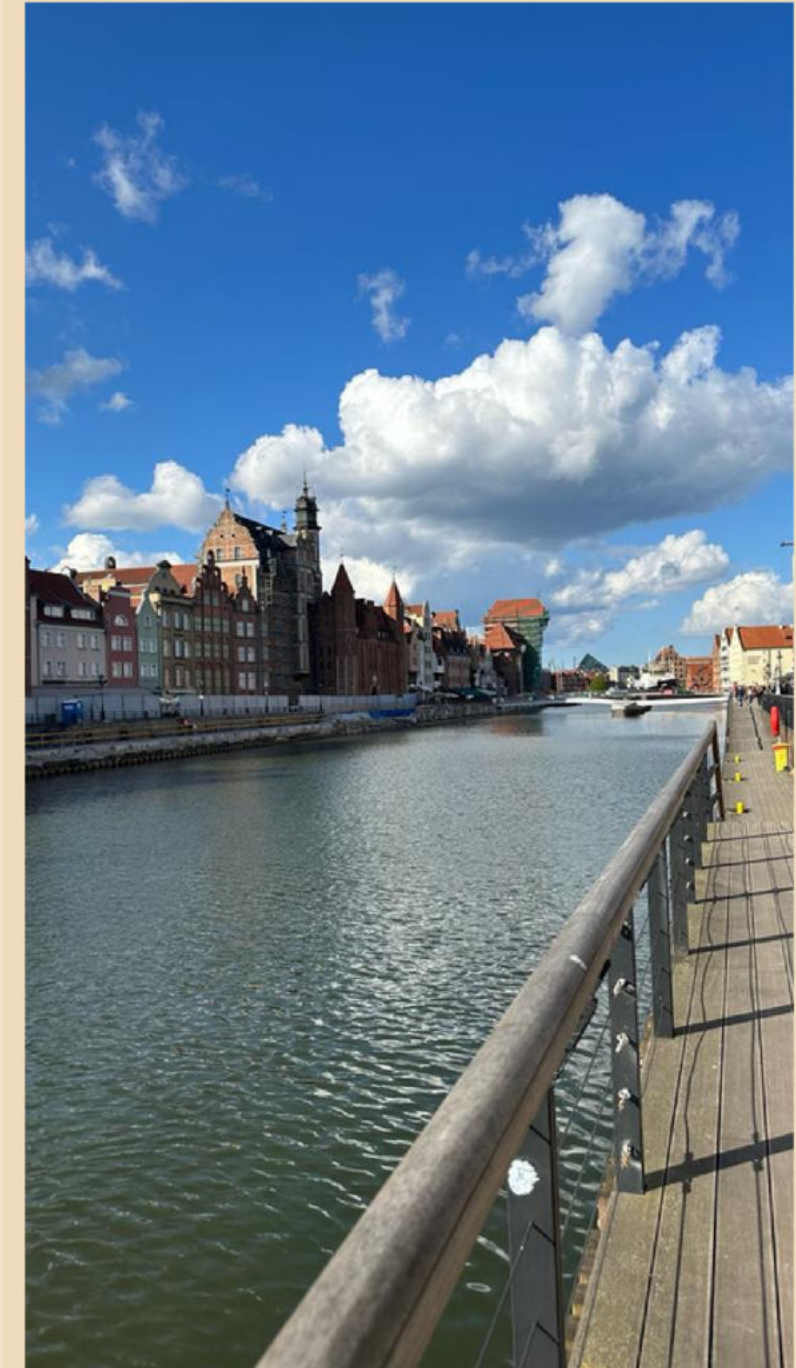
Gdańsk is a city in northern Poland. Gdańsk is Poland's principal seaport and the fourth biggest metropolitan area.
