





Sopot is a small town located in northern Poland, it has a shore to the Baltic Sea.






Gdańsk

Our trip to Gdańsk & Sopot




We got to see Gdańsk and Sopot's beauty with our lovely tour guide.

There were beautiful structures such as Neptune's Fountain and St. Mary's Church.




Motława River in Gdańsk
